Speakers:

Dr Karen Koh is a Consultant Dermatologist. Her main interests include management of patients with skin cancer, acne, eczema, psoriasis, and also the care of paediatric patients with various conditions of the skin. She works as a Visiting Dermatologist at the Royal Adelaide Hospital, teaching Dermatology trainees about surgical management of skin cancers. Dr Koh also does public clinics as a Visiting Specialist at the Women's and Children's Hospital, where she sees children and maternity patients with general skin problems. She also has an interest in laser treatment for vascular birthmarks (e.g. port wine stains) and holds clinics for adults and children at the WCH.
